

How do I login to Cirrus

Radboud University uses the Cirrus Assessment software for digital exams. This software will already have been started once you enter the exam room.


You log in to the software using your student number and password.



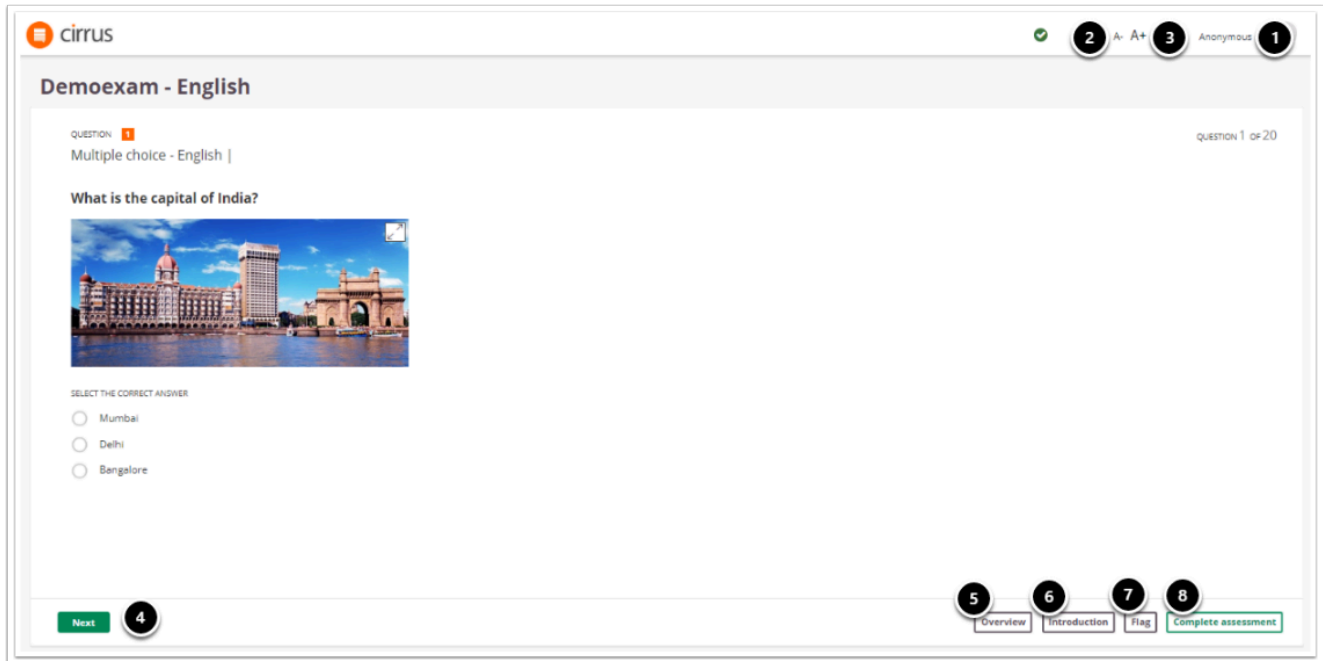
Start Assessment

How do I navigate within Cirrus

After starting the exam and filling in the code, the following screen is shown.



1. States your name.
2. Click here to reduce the font size. (this can be done during the whole exam)
3. Click here to enhance the font size. (this can be done during the whole exam)
4. Click on **Next** after answering the question.
5. Click on **Overview** to see which questions still need answering.
6. Click on **Introduction** to read the introduction page of the exam.
7. Click on **Flag** to mark a question.
8. Click on **Complete assessment** after answering all questions and hand in the exam.

Radboud University uses the Cirrus Assessment software for digital exams. Open the **Chrome** browser and type in the address cirrus.ru.nl.


You log in to the software using your student number and password. Please ensure that you have these available at the start of the test.


